Weather

The month of September can provide some weather extremes, because summer has a habit of lingering. Temperatures can approach 100 degrees, but generally average in the high 70s to mid 80s and it can be humid. Just to be safe, prepare for typical fall weather.

Trave

Interstate highways I-65, I-64 and I-71 intersect Louisville for convenient vehicle travel and the airport is 7 miles south of downtown, making travel time to the hotel about 20 minutes depending on the time of day. Most major airlines serve Louisville



Attractions within walking distance from the hotel, just to name a few, include the Muhammad Ali Center, Belle of Louisville riverboat, Louisville Slugger Museum and Baseball Bat Factory, the Kentucky Center for the Arts, Louisville Glassworks, Frazier Historical Arms Museum and the downtown entertainment center, Fourth Street Live. Further out is Churchill Downs and the Kentucky Derby Museum. The Horseshoe Casino is about a 45-minute drive across the bridge in southern Indiana.

Guest/Spouse Program

The Guest Committee has planned two days of activities. On Monday a tour will showcase many of the outstanding attractions and the architecture of modern Louisville and the third largest collection of Victorian mansions in the U.S. are found in the Old Louisville neighborhood. This tour will include stops at the Louisville Glassworks and the studios of Architectural Glass Art.

On Tuesday, the bus will take you to the Carl Pollard Gallery located at the Kentucky Derby Museum, which is adjacent to the Churchill Downs Race Track, home of the Kentucky Derby.
